



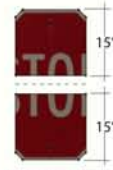
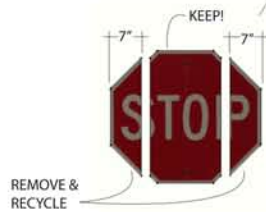

THE PARTS

DONATED	(2) 30"x30" CrossWalk signs
DONATED	(1) 30"x30" Stop sign
\$2	(1) 30"x14"x3/16" Clear Plexi
\$6.98	(1) 30" Piano Hinge
\$5.60	(1) box self-taping sheet metal screws, #6 x 1/2"
\$4.98	(1) roll of duct tape – just because
\$9.17	(1) 4x4 post, 8'tall
\$4.68	(1) 50lb bag of Fast Set Sakrete
\$2.46	(3) 3/8" x 1 1/2" Lag Screws
\$0.98	(1) 10 ct 3/8" washers

THE TOOLS

- A means to cut metal signs.** We used a circular saw with a metal cutting blade.
 - A means to score metal signs.** We used a circular saw with a metal cutting blade set at a depth less than the thickness of the metal sign.
 - A means to bend metal after its been scored.** We used a Craftsman adjustable clamping table. In tough spots, we used a 2 1/2 lb sledge hammer.
 - A cordless drill with a nut driver the size of the self-tapping screws.**
 - A shovel to dig the post hole.**
 - A 5 gal. bucket to mix concrete in.**
 - A ratchet and 9/16" socket to lag screw the Free Little Library to the post.**
 - Lots of extra and redundant tools because you always seem to misplace one or two along the way (no, just us?)!**
